## Montclair Youth Center Building Features

**Information Area** - A front desk where youth can sign up to be members of the Center. Members will also be required to check-in and check-out.

**Assembly Room** - A multipurpose room that can accommodate up to 90 people and can be divided into two smaller rooms. Room can be used for meetings, classes, workshops, presentations, karaoke and fitness video games.

**Study Room** - A quiet room where youth can do homework and study.

**Snack Bar & Lounge** - A place where youth can purchase a variety of snacks, spend time with friends and cooking demonstrations can be held.

**Arts & Crafts Room** - A room dedicated to arts & crafts, complete with storage and a sink.

**Cyber Café** - An open area with ten computers for youth to write papers, do research and surf the internet while being monitored.

**Game Area** - An open room that features two air hockey tables, a pool table, two foosball tables and ping pong table.

**Patio Area** - An outdoor area for bar-b-ques, movie nights and special events.

## Montclair Youth Center Information

The Montclair Youth Center is **FREE** to youth in 7th-10th grades who live or attend school in Montclair (proof required).

Youth can become members of the Youth Center by registering at the Youth Center.

The Center is open Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 2-6 p.m., Tuesday from 1-6 p.m. and Friday from 2- 8 p.m. Center may be closed for holidays and special events.

The Center offers a drop-in program, and youth can come as often as they like.
