



## City of Montclair Emergency Directive No. 01

### SUBJECT: SPECIAL DAILY STORE HOURS FOR DESIGNATED INDIVIDUALS

On Monday, March 16, 2020, the Montclair City Council adopted Resolution No. 20-3263 declaring a local public health emergency in the City of Montclair in relation to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

In declaring a local public health emergency, the City Council invoked Section 6.080.060 of Chapter 6.08 of Title 6 of the Montclair Municipal Code providing that the City Manager, as Director of Emergency Services, is empowered to *"make and issue rules and regulations on matters reasonably related to the protection of life and property as affected by such emergency."*

By virtue of authority vested in me as Director of Emergency Services, pursuant to Section 6.080.060 of Chapter 6.08 of Title 6 of the Montclair Municipal Code, and to protect the health of the categories of individuals listed below, I hereby declare and order the following to be necessary for the protection of life and property:

- Excluding casual dining restaurants, fast casual restaurants, and fast food/quick-service restaurants, businesses in the City of Montclair selling foodstuffs, medication, AND / OR basic household NECESSITIES shall immediately establish designated "SPECIAL" daily hours of operation and pickup service for the following category of individuals, separate from the general population – STORE HOURS PROVIDED FOR IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS DIRECTIVE SHALL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF STORE MANAGEMENT / OWNERSHIP:
  - Adult seniors 65 and older, ACCOMPANIED BY NO MORE THAN ONE ADULT COMPANION
  - Pregnant women, ACCOMPANIED BY NO MORE THAN ONE ADULT COMPANION
  - People with disabilities, ACCOMPANIED BY NO MORE THAN ONE ADULT COMPANION
  - People with evidence of a serious underlying medical condition, ACCOMPANIED BY NO MORE THAN ONE ADULT COMPANION
  - OTHER CATEGORIES OF SHOPPERS AS DETERMINED BY STORE MANAGEMENT/ OWNERSHIP
- Businesses in the City of Montclair selling foodstuffs, medication, AND / OR basic household NECESSITIES shall visibly advertise and display the designated "SPECIAL" daily hours of operation and pickup service on MINIMUM SIZE 20" x 30" POSTERS, using no less than one-inch font, and mounted on the MAIN ENTRY DOOR FORE EACH respective business.
- Businesses in the City of Montclair SELLING foodstuffs, medication, AND / OR basic household NECESSITIES shall comply with Montclair Emergency Directive No. 01 immediately and until Montclair Emergency Directive No. 01 is rescinded.
